A guide to obtain you first residence permit

STEP1: Postal Kit Application

International Students have to apply for their residence permit by submitting the Postal Applicant kit at a Post Office of their preference.

Within 8 days form their arrival in Italy, international students have to go to the Postal Office, take the Application Kit, fill it and return to the Postal Office with all documents.

Attention: if you make these procedures over the deadline your residence permit request will be denied.

STEP2: 1st Appointment with the Immigration Office at Police Headquarters (Questura) st. Sandro Botticelli 4, 25124 Brescia

Students are invited to go to the office on the date and time specified on the postal receipt to have photo and fingerprints taken.

STEP3: Schedule of the 2nd appointment with the immigration office at Questura, st, Sandro Botticelli 4 25124 Brescia

Students will receive the 2nd appointment with the immigration office for the collection of their reiisidency permit by SMS or by registered postal mail.

STEP4: 2nd Appointment with the Immigration office at Questura in st. Sandro Botticelli 4 25124 Brescia

Students can finally collect their residency permit.
